

Trail Ridge Road/Rocky Mountain National Park/Alpine Visitors Center Scenic Ride 126 Miles Round Trip

Park pass required (**\$10 per person obtained at Park Entrance**)

Don't lose your pass – required for entry into Park on return trip.

**Note: Due to extreme altitude changes, there can be significant temperature changes on this ride.
Come prepared!**

- 1) Exit Thunder Mountain Harley Davidson left on Byrd Drive then left on Crossroads Blvd. and merge right onto I-25. Go South 2 miles to US-34. (Exit 257). Turn right on US-34 (West) to Estes Park - 37 miles.
- 2) Stay on US-34 to Trail Ridge Road and Park Entrance. Alpine Visitors Center is 23 miles.
- 3) Return trip from Visitors Center - turn left onto Trail Ridge Road toward Estes Park.
- 4) Continue on US-34 East, to I-25.
- 5) Merge onto I-25 North (right turn), continue North 2 miles to Exit 259 Crossroads Blvd. Veer left at round-about to go West on Crossroads Blvd., then turn right on Byrd Drive returning to Thunder Mountain Harley Davidson.

**Trail Ridge Road is the highest continuous motorway in the United States, with more than eight miles lying above 11,000 feet and a maximum elevation of 12,183 feet. This ride provides spectacular views of the majestic scenery of Rocky Mountain National Park.*
